#### 9. Enhancement of the resources during last five year

New books are procured from time to time, for the departmental library, all the faculty members have donated many of the books to the library, as well as they all shares their personal reference books and journals with the colleagues and the P.G students as well as research scholars as per the need. Microscopic image capture unit have been purchased being utilized for demonstration and explanation. Department maintain an up-to-date wall magazine as source of recent information in the field of biological sciences, an ABBOT microscope attaching camera is made available. Specimens collected during excursion tours are also added every year to the collection.

#### 10. Modern teaching method

The faculty members have the modern teaching methods other than lecture method. Department have, 74 explanatory charts, OHP and slide projector—and the faculty members are using these teaching aids for effective their teaching. Some faculty members prepare their lectures on power point by downloading figures and illustrations from internet. Seminars, home assignment, group discussion, are other methods of teaching usually employed by the faculty members. The field visits to nearby forest reserves are also organized every year, as a mean for the direct exposure of the students with the nature, the environment conservation/ protection methods in use and about the plants and animals' in their natural habitat. Visits are also organized to the, fish culture, sericulture and vermiculture centre for updating of the students with the advancement in agro based industries.
