Promotion

- Promotion from std XIth to std XIIth will be on the average of the marks scored in the four unit tests, home assignments and the two terminal examinations during the year. The promotion rules are as follows.
 - Minimum marks for passing in a subject are 35%

c. Internal Examination: Junior College

Junior College students will have to appear for 4 Unit Tests and Term end examinations. Guardians/ Parents of the Junior College students should verify the performance of the ward's examinations by scrutinizing the progress card. According to the rules laid down by the Maharastra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, promotion to the SYJC class will be determined on the basis of the marks obtained at the Unit Tests and Two Term end examinations.

The final result of a student will be dicided on the basis of the average of marks obtained at these test examinations, the formula being = (a) + (b) + (c)/3 per subject.

Senior College:

All students will have to compulsorily appear for the following examinations.

a) Unit Tests.

b) Annual Test Examination in the second week of February Students ramaining absent from the above exams without sufficient reasons/permission shall be fined suitably, apart from any other disciplinary action. A score of less than 20% marks in each of the examinations will be treated as absence and shall be penalised accordingly.

d) Enrolment:

All new entrants in the Senior College i.e. Part-1 students will have to enrol themselves in the University. Students from other Universities or external students must also submit University Enrolment form. The form will be supplied by the College at the time of admission. No application form will be accepted unless accompained by the Enrolement form A fine of Rs.25/- is imposed by the University if the enrolment form alongwith the enrolment fee does not reach the University within the prescribed time.

e) Identity Card:

A] Every bonafied student of the College should have the Identity Card.
