3.4.1 Extension activities in the neighborhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing students to social issues and holistic development during the last five years

Response:

The college use to organize a variety of extension activities with the active involvement of teachers to inculcate the awareness and responsibilities among the students regarding the common social issues. Students are encouraged to develop a social mindset for the betterment of society and social harmony. These activities are conducted by various departments individually but mostly in collaboration with NSS and NCC unit of the college. The college is running a National Service scheme (NSS) unit with the capacity of 200 students and a National Cadet Corps (NCC) unit with separate boys and girls units. With the involvement of NSS / NCC the college use to organize events like blood donation camps, AIDS awareness programs, Cleanliness drives in nearby localities, campus cleanliness, Women empowerment programs, Road safety awareness programs etc. NSS unit, every year organize a seven day residential camp at nearby villages; where they organize the events like blood group detection camp, free eye checking, Superstition eradication program, importance of water and hygiene, water and environment conservation, Women and child labor, and residential cleanliness. Such residential camps were organized by NSS unit in nearby villages like Ugawa (2016), Keliveli (2017) and Goregaon (2018 & 2019). NSS unit also counter burning social evils and issues by spreading awareness through street plays. Seeing the work and its impact our parent University, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati has awarded the college with University level cleanliness award during 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21. Every year on the occasion of Late Dr. Bhausaheb

Deshmukh Jayanti Utsav, Department of Biochemistry of the college organizes blood donation camp in association with NGO or Govt. organization. Also every year on 1st December, college organizes AIDS awareness rally in collaboration with Main Civil hospital, Akola. During the Covid- 19 pandemic, several NSS/ NCC students has worked as volunteers and also distributed masks, sanitizer and made the general public aware about pandemic situation and severity. Department of Chemistry was on the frontline to prepare the sanitizer and provide it to sanitize the Police vehicles and also to policemen in the city. The Commissioner of Akola Municipal Corporation has appreciated the work by the Department and college and also given appreciation letter. Apart from this, every year Department of Home Science organizes Nutrition week and breast feeding week; Department of Botany organizes forest conservation day, world wetland day every year, also conducted a workshop for formers on biofertilizer preparation on 13th January 2018; a MCQ series for life science students of PG in 2020 and a National workshop on competitive examination for life science students during 26th to 31 May 2020. As a token impact of sensitizing students regarding social issues is reflected in their active contribution in natural disaster management like floods and Covid pandemics. Some of the students have been awarded and felicitated by several NGO's and Government of Maharashtra.

Some most important activities carried out by NSS & NCC Units of the College individually or in Collaboration with GOs/ NGOs

Cleanliness drive of NSS/ NCC units of the College:

Cleanliness Awareness (Swachh Bharat Abhiyan):

I. Inauguration (16th August 2016):

In the new academic session, to introduce the newly admitted NSS cadets, the orientation class of NSS and Inaugurated Cleanliness drive and awareness program. It was inaugurated on 16th August 2016 and the events were conducted during next two weeks.

II. Cleanliness drive (17th August 2016):

On 17th August 2016, the NSS cadets did the cleanliness of college campus. They sweep the entire campus, infrastructure; collect all the garbage and put into the dust bins; green waste into vermicomposting pit. Also collected the plastic waste material and dispose.

III. Samajik Vrukshabandhan (18th August 2016):

IV. Cleanliness awareness rally (20th August 2016):

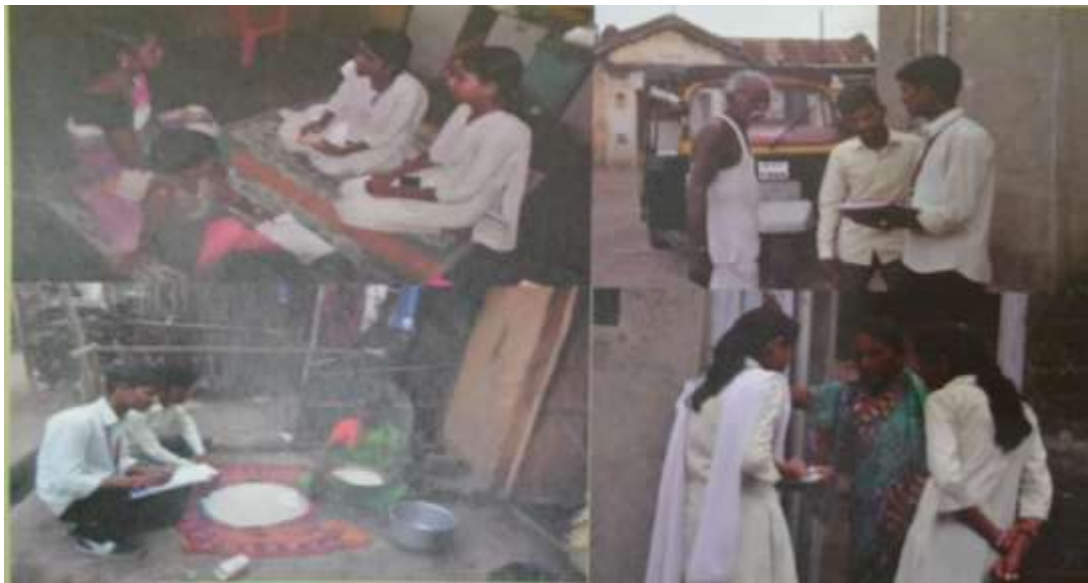

During this rally, the cadets tried to explain the importance of cleanliness in routine life. 100 NSS cadets were participated in this rally.

V. Cleanliness awareness (23rd August 2016):

In this phase of cleanliness awareness drive, 60 NSS cadets were practice to explain the importance of cleanliness in routine life to each family in the adopted village Keliveli. They have visited about 420 families and also surveys about how many families have the toilets.

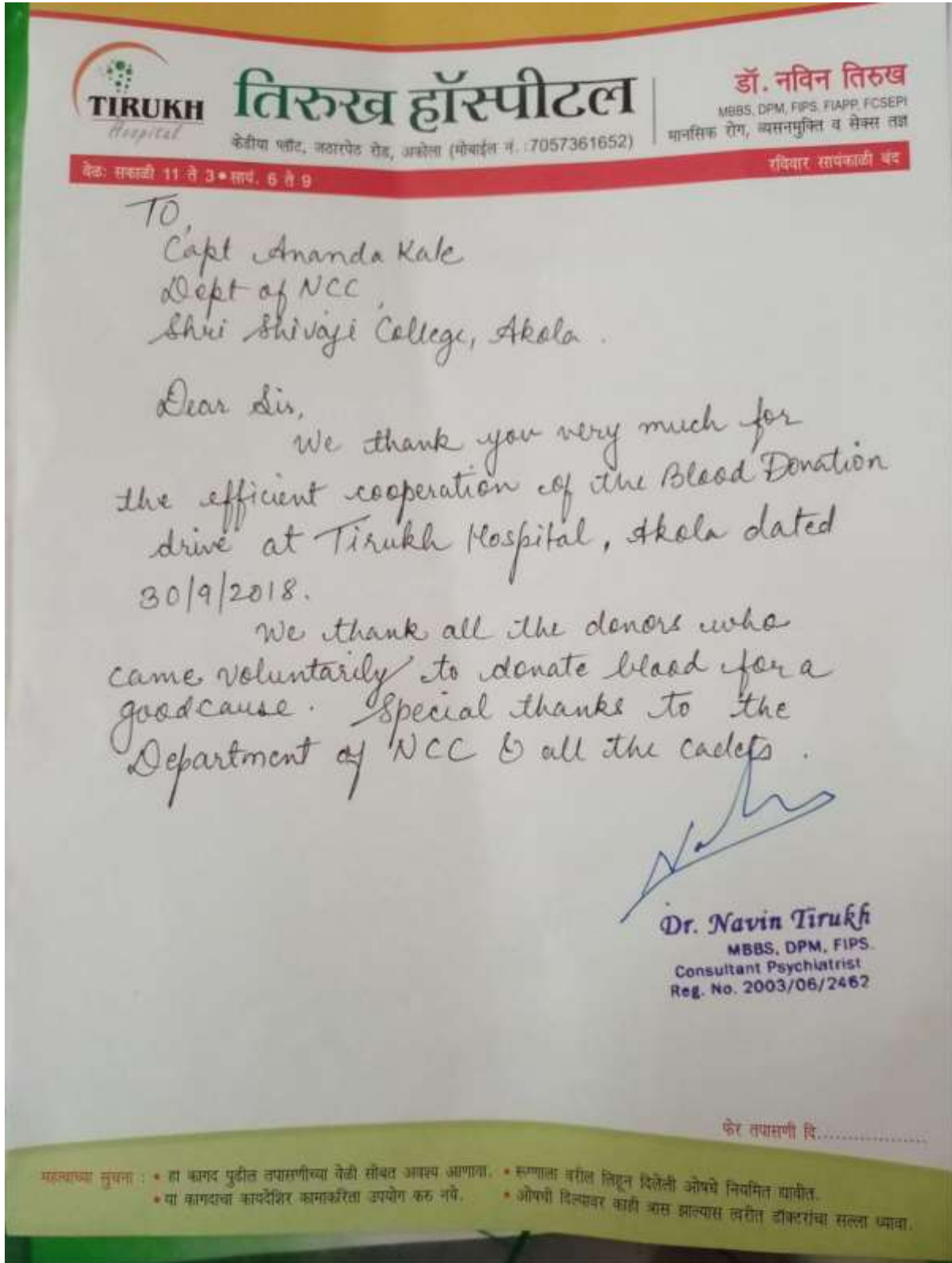

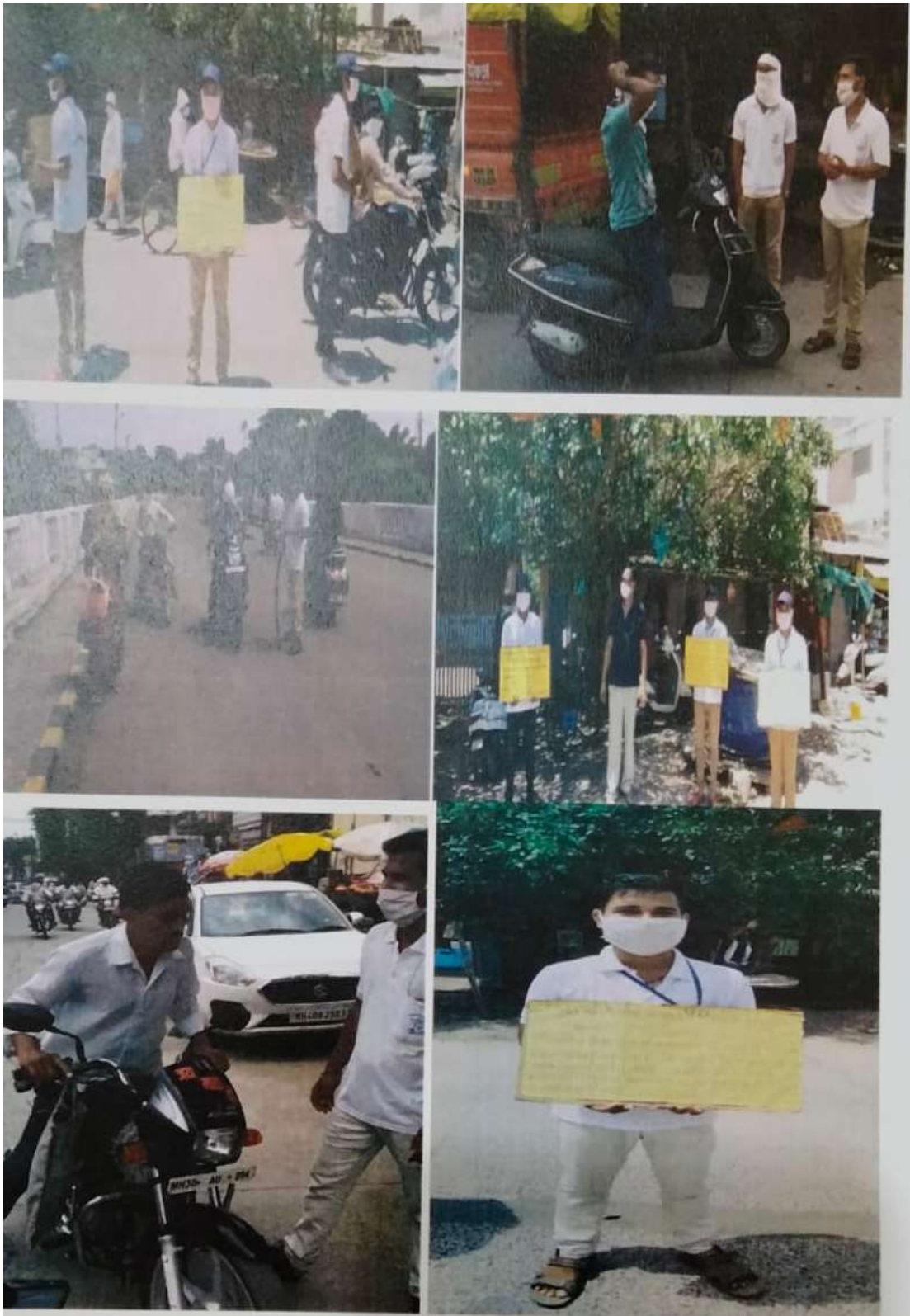

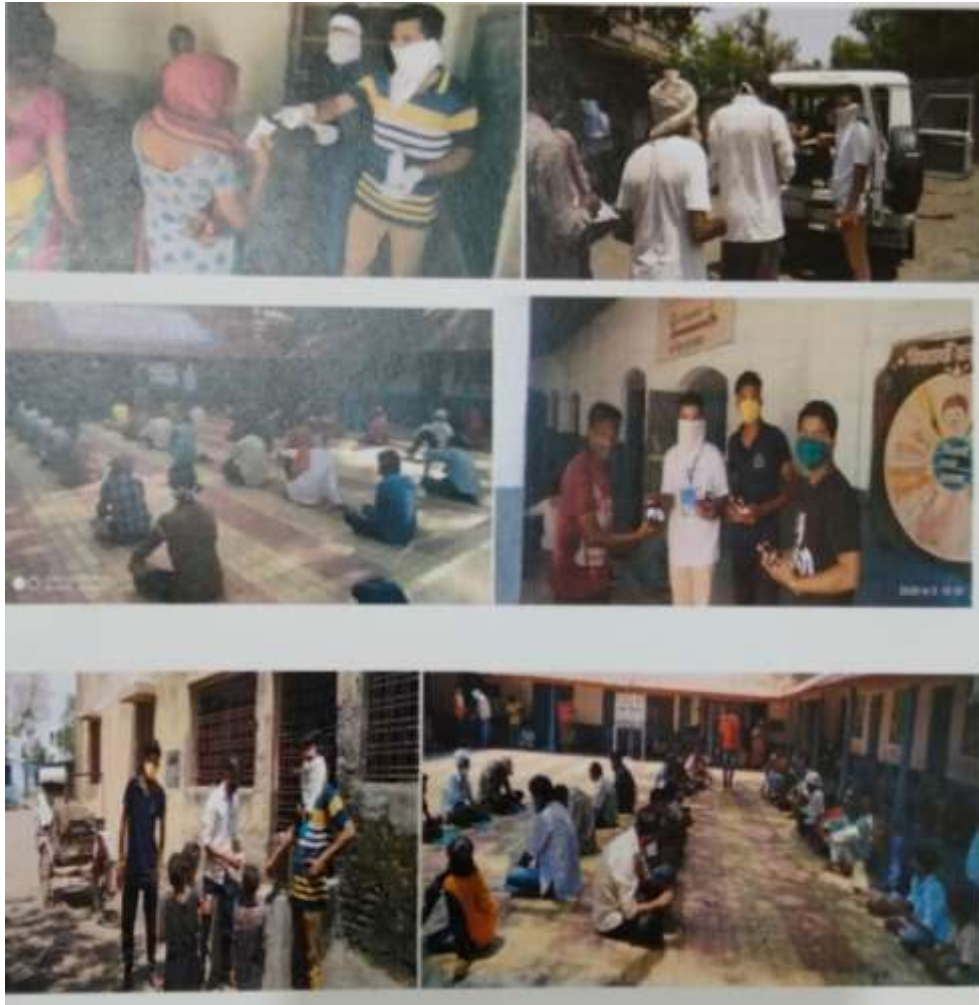
