14. Innovations / Contributions in Teaching

- a. Teaching Methods : Lectures, Seminars, Use of Charts, demonstrations etc methods using for teaching.

15. Role in college activities.

(1) As I am co-ordinator of Health unit of our college, arranging various health programme like Breast feeding week in collaboration with Ob.Gy. Society. Nutrition week in collaboration with Home Science department. Lectures were arranged on Anaemia, Rubella etc. for college students. Specialist doctors from Akola were invited to deliver the lectures.

(2) I am doing Health check up of all girl student of our college every year and giving treatment to them whenever necessary.

(3) As my minor project is on comparative study of Anaemia in Adolescent Girls in Urban and Rural population with treatment. I being a Doctor have decided to check blood Hemoglobin percentage and blood group detection of all our college girls. My aim is to treat all the anaemic girls of our college & get rid of Anaemia in adolescent girls to reduce maternal mortality in future.

16. Role in university activities

(1) I am x-member of Board of students in science of Home Science faculty, took active participation in deciding about changes in syllabus.

(2) Active participation in setting question papers conducting practicals as on External/Internal Examiner.

17. Extension activities / consultancy/ community works.

(1) Various 'Health Camps', were conducted. Medical check up at slum area of Umari and also at Jatharpeth Akola with distribution of Medicines and tonics.





- (2) Twice visited Vrudhashram at Kaulkhed. Medical examination of all old women was done. Medicines including tonics were given to them. In the second visit we celebrated Dipawali with them. Sweets, New Saries and shawls were distributed by all our college staff members



- (3) Also visited the orphan centre at Adarsha colony. Medical check up of all girls & women was done. Medicine was given. New series were distributed by our college staff membes.
- (4) Arranged a health camp at Keliveli in collaboration with N.S.S. camp. Medical checkup of all girls and ladies was done. Medicines were given. Estimation of Hemoglobin percentage in blood & blood group detection of about 100 adolescent girls of Keliveli was done. Hematonics (tonics) were given to all anaemic girls.

- (5) During Nutrition week arranged blood Hemoglobin & blood group detection camp for all girl students of our college, Hemotonics (tonics) was given to all anaemic students
- (6) Rubella Vaccination programme was arranged in our college with collaboration with Government Medical college Intern's doctors and Obstetrics & Gynaecological society Akola. Initially they showed a film on Rubella for Rubella awareness and lecture was delivered by Dr. Mrs. Bhusari for all girl students & lady staff of our college. Rubella Vaccination camp was arranged in our Home Science department and about 100 girl students Rubells vaccine was given.
